Cleveland, OH – The Great Lakes Recreational Vehicle Association’s Ohio RV Supershow, held January 6-10, 2010 at the I-X Center will showcase 600 of the newest RVs and all NEW is Brian Brawdy and The Green RV. Brawdy and The Green RV will be at the show to demonstrate how an RV can be eco-friendly while still keeping all its comforts. He also will conduct seminars throughout the run of the event.

“In 2008 I traveled to 48 contiguous states in just 11 months with The Green RV,” said Brian Brawdy. “I’m thrilled to be a part of the Ohio RV Supershow this year. This event will be my first public show to feature my next generation green/independence RV designed with the most energy efficient products such as solar panels and wind turbines.”

The Green RV is powered by Ford's Power Stroke V-8 diesel engine, while also harnessing power through the use of 11 solar panels and three wind turbines to help power the RV’s various electrical appliances. The Green RV also captures, stores, and sanitizes rainwater for later use, but doesn't skimp on comfort and interior amenities. The vehicle features all the usual RV bells and whistles, including a complete kitchen, a queen-sized bed, a full bath, entertainment center, and button-controlled sliding walls.
